Trapac Terminal Access on 08/13/17

On Sunday, August 13, CicLAvia—San Pedro Meets Wilmington will remove cars from certain streets in San Pedro and Wilmington and open them up for people to walk, skate, bike, play, and explore. There will be no parking or vehicle access on certain streets during CicLAvia (see map). The event runs from 9am to 4pm with street closures in effect from 7am to 6pm.

Certain streets in San Pedro and Wilmington will be closed from 7am to approximately 6pm.

There will be limited access to the Trapac Terminal from 7 am to 6 pm. During this time all trucks must use the 110 north bound exit at Harry Bridges to access the terminal. The 110 south bound exit at Harry Bridges will be closed. See map.

Trucks traveling Southbound on the 110 must continue onto the 47/Vincent Thomas Bridge and exit Ferry Street to loop back onto the 110 N and follow directions above.

Trucks traveling west on Harry Bridges will be able to enter Terminal at Access Road and Bay View Drive.

Yang Ming and China Shipping Terminal Access on 08/13/17

Ingress and Egress via 110 n/b freeway only - trucks will not be allowed to travel along John S. Gibson Blvd as it will be closed to cars. Trucks traveling south bound on the 110 must exit at Gaffey and get back onto the 110 N/B to access Terminal via John S Gibson. See map.

Trucks traveling Southbound on the 110 must continue onto the 47/Vincent Thomas Bridge and exit Ferry Street to loop back onto the 110 N and follow directions above.
