JUNETEENTH PAID HOLIDAY- REVISED

Juneteenth, Thursday, June 19, 2025, will be a paid holiday.

There shall be no work on the first shift (07:00-17:00) June 19th for all locals coastwise (the provision for “no work” shall not apply to passenger ships, essential military cargo, and emergencies as defined in Section 5.24). Work shall resume on the second shift.”

Under the current contract, a person does not have to meet the availability requirement (work two (2) days, Monday through Friday, exclusive of the day the holiday falls) if you have worked 1300 hours or more in the prior payroll year (2024) to receive the Juneteenth paid holiday.

Registered members who have 800 qualifying hours in the prior payroll year (2024) but less than 1300 hours must meet the availability requirements for at least two (2) of the five (5) days Monday through Friday (exclusive of the day of the holiday) during the payroll week in which the holiday falls in order to receive a paid holiday for Juneteenth. This means you must work or meet the availability requirements for at least two (2) days, Monday, June 16; Tuesday, June 17; Wednesday, June 18; or Friday, June 20, 2025.

Individuals taking vacation during the holiday week must report the vacation to the Records Clerk in the Dispatch Hall on or before Friday, June 20, 2025. Individuals not receiving holiday pay because of illness, injury, jury duty, etc., must file a claim with the Records Clerk before Friday, August 1, 2025, to receive Juneteenth holiday pay. The Juneteenth holiday pay will be paid on the payroll check of June 27, 2025.
