LABOR DAY PAID HOLIDAY

Labor Day, Monday, September 1, 2025, is a paid holiday. Only registered members who have 800 qualifying hours in the prior payroll year (2024) and meet the availability requirement for at least two of the five days Monday through Friday (exclusive of the holiday) will receive a paid holiday for Labor Day. This means you must work or meet the availability requirement for at least two of these days, Tuesday, September 2nd; Wednesday, September 3rd; Thursday, September 4th; and Friday, September 5, 2025.

THE LABOR DAY PAID HOLIDAY IS ONE OF THE HOLIDAYS THAT EVERYONE HAS TO MEET THE TWO DAY AVAILABILITY REQUIREMENT

Persons taking vacation during the holiday week must report the vacation to the Records Clerk in the Dispatch Hall on or before Friday, September 5, 2025, or you will not receive the holiday pay.

Persons not receiving holiday pay because of illness, injury, jury duty, etc., must file a claim with the Records Clerk on or before Friday, October 17, 2025.

The Labor Day holiday pay will be paid on Friday, September 12, 2025.

Some paid holiday notes:

- Vacation must be taken Monday through Friday
- To be made available, means you cannot pass a job in your skill or category or a clerk job
- Two shifts in one day only counts as one day working. (Example: Work Tuesday, Double-up Tuesday Night. This is one day of the requirement; You have worked two shifts in day.)
