MEMO REGARDING KAISER PERMANENTE SERVICES

Dear Brothers & Sisters,

Kaiser Permanente has received a strike notice from the United Nurses Associations of California/Union of Health Care Professionals (UNAC/UHCP).

UNAC/UHCP has issued notice for an open-ended strike beginning Monday, January 26, 2026, at some of the facilities in Southern California. A strike notice doesn't mean a strike will happen. If a strike does happen, the hospitals and medical offices will stay open. Some pharmacies would close, so please pick up any prescriptions before January 26. Kaiser Permanente has robust plans in place to ensure continued care. It's possible they may need to reschedule some non-urgent appointments and elective surgeries. If you have an appointment scheduled on the date of a possible strike date, please do not cancel or reschedule. Kaiser Permanente will reach out to you if they have to reschedule your care. Your care is their priority.

To get prescriptions during a strike: Some pharmacies might be closed. The most convenient way to fill your prescription is through mail-order delivery services. We encourage you to sign up on kp.org/pharmacy or the Kaiser Permanente app. Estimated delivery times based on recent mail trends are on kp.org. Typically, you should receive your medications in about 3 to 5 days. There's no cost for shipping. You may also go to a Kaiser Permanente pharmacy before January 26, 2026. Please be sure to pick up any prescriptions you may have already filled before then.

After January 26, open pharmacies will be listed on kp.org. Kaiser Permanente has made extensive preparations to provide pharmacy services and sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this strike activity may cause.

Prescription delivery: You may sign-up for Kaiser Permanente mail-order delivery service on kp.org/pharmacy or at kp.org, you can find an estimated delivery time based on recent mail trends.

Contact Member Services if you have questions, open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week (closed holidays). *Hold times may be longer than usual during a strike.*
