ELECTION RULES

Section IX Campaign Rules

- k. **Campaign Banners** – Any posting larger than 2' x 3' shall be considered a banner. A banner may be hung according to the following:
1. No banner may be larger than 6' x 3'.
 2. No campaign banner shall be allowed inside or on the Dispatch Hall.
 3. Banners may be placed on the Dispatch Hall fences.
 4. Each candidate is allowed to hang a maximum of three (3) banners.
 5. The Local retains the right to limit access to portions of the fence.
 6. Banners that are personally produced are allowed. Professionally produced banners are not allowed unless the banner(s) is purchased at a union shop and indicates a union bug.
 7. The use of nails, staples, glues, or other means used to affix a banner that causes damage to any Dispatch Hall fences is strictly prohibited. Any damage caused by the hanging of any campaign poster may be repaired by order of the Secretary-Treasurer at the offending member's expense.
 8. **Each candidate or member that hangs a banner shall remove that banner no later than seven (7) days after the conclusion of elections.**
 9. **Any banner hung in violation of these rules may be removed by the Secretary-Treasurer at the responsible candidate's or member's expense!**
 10. All candidates are prohibited from placing campaign posters, banners, literature or handbills in any store, restaurant, bank, or other public place of business.
- l. **Campaign Posters** – Any posting not larger than 2' by 3' shall be considered a poster. Posters may be hung according to the rules stated above.

INDIVIDUALS GUILTY OF REMOVING A CANDIDATE BANNER WITHOUT PERMISSION MAY BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION.
