## **REGULAR MEMBERSHIP MEETING** **THURSDAY, JUNE 4, 2026 @ 7:30 P.M.** **ILWU MEMORIAL HALL**

**ILWU Local 63** Officers notified the Pacific Maritime Association that they will hold a Stop-Work Meeting on Thursday, June 4, 2026, second shift only, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m. No clerk labor will be available for work from the hours of 5:00 p.m. to 3:00 a.m. Thursday, June 4, 2026, except for passenger ships, essential military cargo, DST rail, and emergencies, as defined in Section 5.24 of the Contract.

In addition, Longshore Mechanics can be directed to monitor reefers, pursuant to Section 2.43 of the LA-Long Beach Mechanics Port Supplementary Agreement. The Union has agreed to a one-hour extension up to 6:00 p.m. to finish and sail vessels and to complete the 8-hour guarantee for 9:00 a.m. vessel starts, pursuant to Section 2.41 of the PCL&CA.

Where no second shift is contemplated due to the Stop-Work Meeting on Thursday, June 4, 2026, workers will accept comebacks from Wednesday, June 3, 2026, second shift, to Friday, June 5, 2026, second shift. Rail labor must be released and reordered for Friday, June 5, 2026, if not brought back on Thursday, June 4, 2026.
