JULY 4TH & 5TH 2024 HOLIDAYS

Thursday, July 4, 2024, will be a paid holiday. Only registered persons who have 800 qualifying hours in the prior payroll year (2023) and meet the availability requirements for at least two of the five days Monday through Friday (exclusive of the holiday) during the payroll week in which the holiday falls will receive the paid holiday for July 4, 2024. This means you must work or be available for two days, Monday, July 1st; Tuesday, July 2nd; and Wednesday, July 3, 2024.

Under the current contract one does not have to meet the availability requirement if you worked 1300 hours or more in the prior payroll year (2023) to receive July 4, 2024, holiday pay.

July 5th, Bloody Thursday under the current contract is still a holiday, but **not** a paid holiday.

Persons taking a vacation during the holiday week must report the vacation to the Records Clerk in the Dispatch Hall on or before Wednesday, July 3, 2024.

Persons not receiving holiday pay because of illness, injury, jury duty, etc. must file a claim with the Records Clerk on or before Friday, August 16, 2024.

The July 4, 2024, holiday will be paid on the payroll check issued on Friday, July 12, 2024.
