Please vote for either "BUDGET PROPOSAL A" or "BUDGET PROPOSAL B."

- 1. BUDGET PROPOSAL A: <u>Increase dues by \$19.75 and retain the positions of Health Benefits Officer and Labor Relations Committee Representative/Port Liaison.</u>
- 2. BUDGET PROPOSAL B. Amend the Constitution & Bylaws, Article II, Sections 1 and 3, Article III, Sections 4, 6, and 15, and Article IV, Section 1, and Article V, Section 1 to eliminate the positions of Health Benefits Officer and Labor Relations Committee Representative/Port Liaison.

*The Membership will NOT be assessed the \$13 per member/per month fee for the ICTSI Lawsuit as previously proposed in past dues increase proposals.

<u>Both Budget Proposals balance the 2025 Budget.</u>
