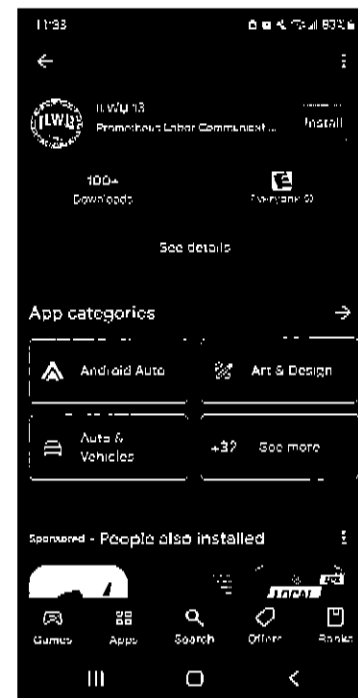

## **URGENT: CALL TO ACTION**

**The ILWU has been pushing back against over-reaching environmental regulations at the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach, that could have devastating long-term impacts on our jobs and communities!**

California Senate Bill (SB) 34, authored by our local, ILWU endorsed, Senator Laura Richardson and her staff, is a big part of that fight. Through their efforts, as well as those of our Local 13, 63 and 94 officers and staff, our legal team of SR Holguin, PC, our lobbying firm of California Advocacy, LA City Councilman Tim McOsker's Office, as well as other supporting legislators, stakeholders and labor organizations, SB 34 has made its way through three (3) Sub-committees in the Senate, as well three (3) Sub-Committees in the Assembly, and is now on the Governor's Desk, awaiting his signature.

The ILWU International and the ILWU Coast Longshore Division are now leading the effort and spearheading a "full court press" to get this legislation signed into law. We also know that opponents of this bill will flood the Governor's Office with calls, emails and social media to have him veto this bill, as it is their last chance to stop it. Here is where you can help, please read the flyer attached to this bulletin and follow the directions there to either call, email or post our message on your social media. The Governor has until October 12, 2025, to sign or veto this bill, as that is 30 days after it passed out of the legislature on September 12, 2025.

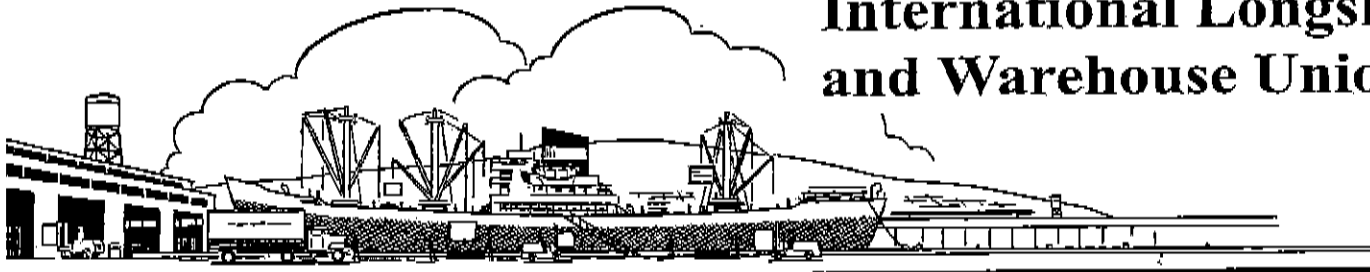

## 2025 FOREMEN HIRING PROCESS WRITTEN EXAM DATE

The Joint Foremen Labor Relations Committee has completed the (1) application and (2) qualifying hours review phases of the foreman promotion process for the Ports of Los Angeles-Long Beach. Those who passed the initial review phases have been sent a letter (by mail) inviting them to take the written test on September 20, 2025. All applicants are required to bring a copy of that invite letter to the written test in order to be eligible to sit for the exam. If there are any applicants who passed the application and qualifying hours review phases, but **did not** receive a written test invite letter, they must get a copy of the letter by accessing the Dockworker Self Service (DSS) Portal where they submitted their original application. On the DSS Portal, they can access and download their scheduling letter to take with them to the written test.

















**Failure to bring the invite letter to the written test on September 20, 2025 is grounds for disqualification.**
