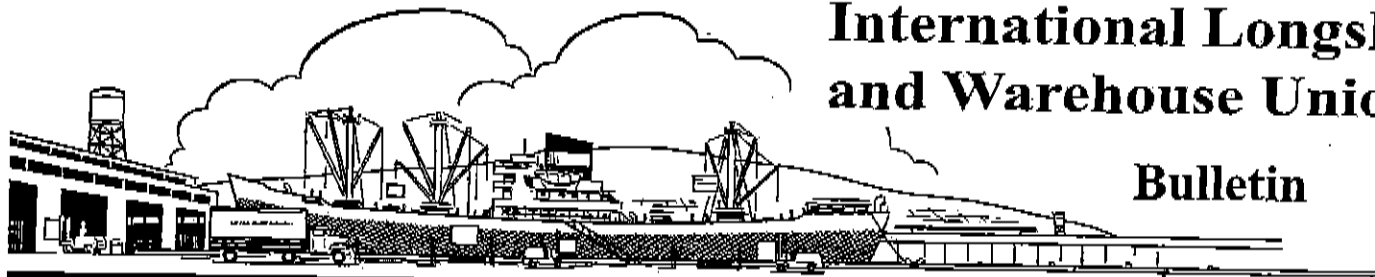
Please note: Comebacks will be on a month-to-month trial (*as manpower is needed*).

CHECK YOUR DUCKET AT THE WINDOW

REMINDER:

All members are responsible for checking their work ducket at the dispatch window before walking away.

What does that mean? First and foremost, make sure it is your registration number on that ducket. Once you leave the window, that job is now yours. (See Dispatch Rules under "Flops" #5: *During the dispatch period, any member wishing to flop must do so before leaving the dispatch window. Once leaving the window with a job and/or the next number has been called, the member is obligated to report to the job, call a replacement, and work until the replacement arrives.*)

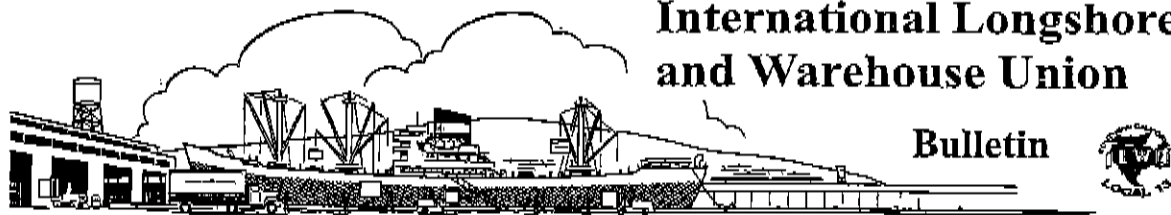
Keep in mind, companies are not accepting duckets that have work numbers scratched off or duckets that have a work number printed on it that does not match the member checking in.

PORT OF LONG BEACH **PIER T (TTI/LB 140)** **REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT**

Brothers & Sisters,

As you may know, the Port of Long Beach (POLB) recently released a Notice of Preparation and Initial Study to seek input on the scope and content of the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the proposed Pier T (TTI/LB 140) marine Terminal Redevelopment Project. The initial study describes the proposed project and provides an initial evaluation of the Project's potential environmental impacts.

If you are interested in providing input on the proposed Pier T Marine Terminal Redevelopment Project, you may do so in two (2) ways:

2. The Port will host a virtual scoping meeting on **Thursday, August 6, 2026, at 11:00 a.m.** during which an overview of the proposed Project and the environmental review process will be provided. Members of the public will have an opportunity to provide comments.

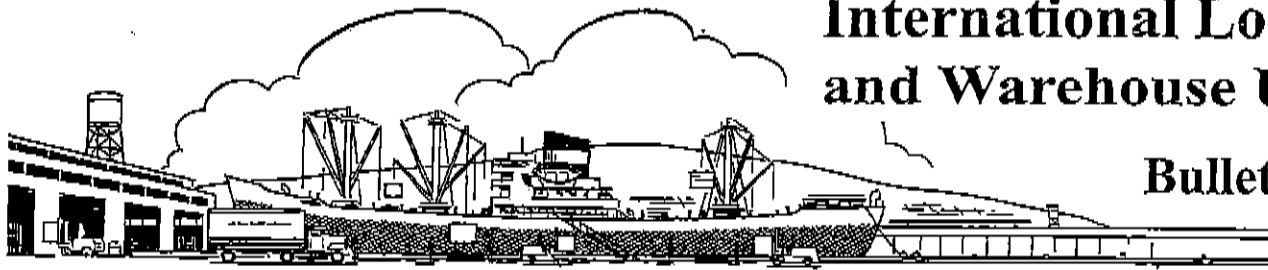

HARRY BRIDGES BIRTHDAY **PAID HOLIDAY**

Harry Bridges Birthday, Tuesday, July 28, 2026, is a paid holiday. Only registered persons who have 800 qualifying hours in the prior payroll year (2025) and meet the availability requirements for at least two of the five days, exclusive of the holiday, Tuesday through Friday will receive a paid holiday for Harry Bridges Birthday. This means you must work or meet the availability requirements for at least two days, Monday, July 27th; Wednesday, July 29th; Thursday, July 30th; and Friday, July 31, 2026.

All work performed on Tuesday, July 28, 2026, will be at the overtime rate.

Under the current contract, one does not have to meet the availability requirement if you worked 1300 hours in the prior payroll year (2025) to receive the Harry Bridges Birthday holiday.

Persons taking a vacation during the holiday week must report the vacation to the Records Clerk in the Dispatch Hall on or before Friday, July 31, 2026, or you will not receive the holiday pay. Persons not receiving holiday pay because of illness, injury, jury duty, etc. must file a claim with the Records Clerk on or before Friday, September 11, 2026.

The Harry Bridges Birthday holiday will be paid on Friday, August 7, 2026.

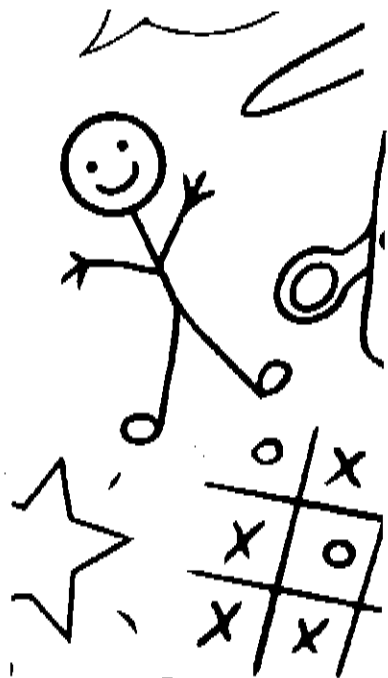

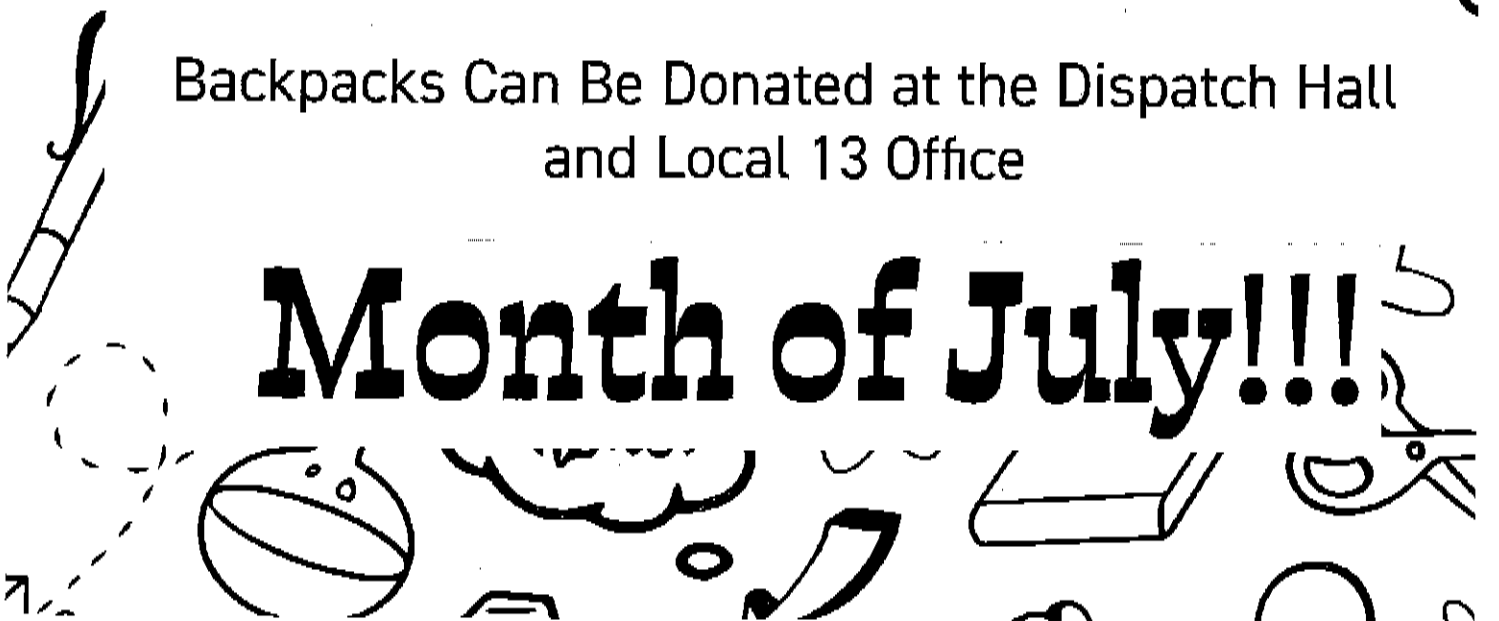

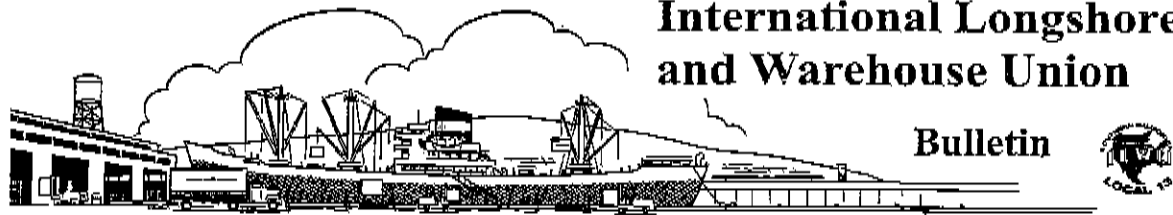

International Longshore and Warehouse Union Local 6 and C&H Sugar Company, Inc. Take Steps Toward Resolving the Parties' Contract Negotiations

For Immediate Release

CROCKETT, CA – July 27, 2026 – The International Longshore and Warehouse Union Local 6 (ILWU Local 6) and C&H Sugar Company, Inc. (“C&H”) today jointly announce that they have agreed to a sixty-day period of continued contract negotiations with high-level executives in an effort to reach agreement.

ILWU Local 6 represents approximately 100 warehouse workers at C&H in Crockett, California, who have been on strike since June 15, 2026. The parties have been far apart on a number of issues. The parties met with a federal mediator several times in July but were unable to reach agreement.

ILWU Local 6 and C&H have agreed to a sixty-day period through September 30, 2026, during which executives from C&H and the ILWU's International Officers will participate in negotiations in an effort to reach an agreement that is good for the workers, the company, and the community. In a showing of good faith, ILWU Local 6 has agreed to return to work during this period, and C&H will withdraw its declaration of impasse.

The parties have committed that decision makers will meet frequently during this period to bargain in good faith and reach agreement on a fair contract.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS FOR LOCAL 13 CONSTITUTION

In this upcoming election, members will be asked to vote on twelve (12) amendments to the Local 13 Constitution. Much of the language in the Constitution dates back to the founding of Local 13. In the decades since, the law and Local 13's interpretation of various provisions have undergone many changes. The following proposed amendments aim to reflect this:

1. Article IV(1)(F) – Nomination of Officers

Change To: In order to have his name placed on the ballot and to hold any office or position, each candidate must have been in good standing and must have worked at least one (1) shift a month as a ~~an active~~ Longshoreman in the industry in this Local or have been working for the ILWU for the previous twelve (12) months. The work requirement ~~This is not applicable to men injured in the industry~~ or otherwise disabled during the previous twelve (12) months.

Reason for change: Clarification of work requirement and revision to treat industrial and non-industrial disability in the same way.

2. Article V(1)(F) – Election of Officers

Change To: A person cannot be a candidate for more than one paid office or paid position at the same time.

Reason for change: Clarification of existing understanding of the meaning of the language.

3. Article VIII(2) – Vacancy of Salaried Office

Change To: Any Elective Salaried Officer, Employee, or Committeeman who absents himself three (3) consecutive times without sufficient cause from the duties and meeting assigned to him or whose conduct is detrimental to the organization, shall have his position declared vacant by the Presiding Officer and, pending notice and hearing on the charges before the Grievance or Trial Committee, he shall not hold any position in the Local for one (1) year.

Reason for change: To align with legal requirements.

4. Article X(1)(A) – Membership Applications

Change To: Applicants for membership in this Union must be qualified to perform the duties necessary for general longshore work; shall be of good moral character and ~~have no serious physical defects which may prove~~ must not be a hazard to himself or his fellow workers. He must be eighteen (18) years of age and ~~must be eligible to citizenship under the laws of the United States.~~

Reason for change: To align with modern standards of equal treatment.

5. *Article X(2) – Membership Applications*

Change To: Any officer or agent, or former officer or agent of a Corporation or Association of Employers, ~~or a deputized city, county or special police,~~ or men proven to be members of, or former members of vigilante groups, shall be prohibited to membership in this Union.

Reason for change: To allow former police officers membership.

6. *Article XI(1)(A) – Dues, Fines and Assessments*

Change To: ~~All fines, assessments or other indebtedness must be paid before your dues will be accepted.~~

Reason for change: To align with legal requirements.

7. *Article XI(1)(C) – Dues, Fines and Assessments*

Change To: Example – (The delinquent date is the 15th day of the month following the month the dues, fines, assessments or other indebtedness were accrued. In months where the 15th falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or Holiday, the delinquent date will be the first Monday after the 15th of the month.)

Reason for change: Clarification of existing understanding of the meaning of the language.

8. *Article XII(1)(A) – Reinstating Members and Withdrawals*

Change To: Members wishing a withdrawal card ~~must be paid up to date with their dues, fines, assessments or other indebtedness for the current month and~~ must intend to quit all work under our jurisdiction. Members wishing a withdrawal card are still liable for their dues, fines, assessments or other indebtedness up to the current month of withdrawal.

Reason for change: To align with legal requirements.

9. *Article XII(1)(B) – Reinstating Members and Withdrawals*

Change To: ~~Those holding withdrawal cards, who do any longshore or waterfront work subject to our jurisdiction, shall be liable to all dues, fines and assessments from the date of issue of withdrawal card.~~

Reason for change: To align with legal requirements.

10. *Article XII(1)(F) – Reinstating Members and Withdrawals*

Change To: ~~No member shall be given a withdrawal card unless he has been an active member in the Local for the past twelve (12) months.~~

Reason for change: To align with legal requirements.

11. *Article XII(1)(G) – Reinstating Members and Withdrawals*

Change To: ~~Withdrawals shall not be issued three (3) months prior to date of termination of the longshore agreement.~~

Reason for change: To align with legal requirements.

12. *Article XII(1)(H) – Reinstating Members and Withdrawals*

Change To: ~~Withdrawals shall not be honored until six (6) months after termination of any strike or lockout.~~

Reason for change: To align with legal requirements.
