SR-103 Union Pacific Overhead Bridge Project

Construction scheduled for 9/5/24 – 1/31/25

DAYTIME / NIGHTTIME CLOSURES

During construction on **9/5/24 – 1/31/25** Caltrans has scheduled lane closures on the southbound State Route 103 (SR-103) between Pacific Coast Highway (PCH) to Henry Ford Avenue. Crews will be conducting striping work prior to beginning bridge work on the Union Pacific Overhead Bridge.

Detour signs will be posted. Motorists should expect delays and are strongly advised to use alternate routes. Real time traffic information can be found at <http://quickmap.dot.ca.gov/>

S/B SR-103 is open to the Anaheim Street exit however you are highly encouraged to use the designated Detour to PCH or an alternate route. The Anaheim Street exit leads to I Street which is a single lane street in each direction.

Detour Routes are as follows:

- Exit to W Pacific Coast Hwy
- Right on E O St.
- Left onto Alameda St
- Left onto N Henry Ford Ave
- Continue onto SB 103 / SB 47

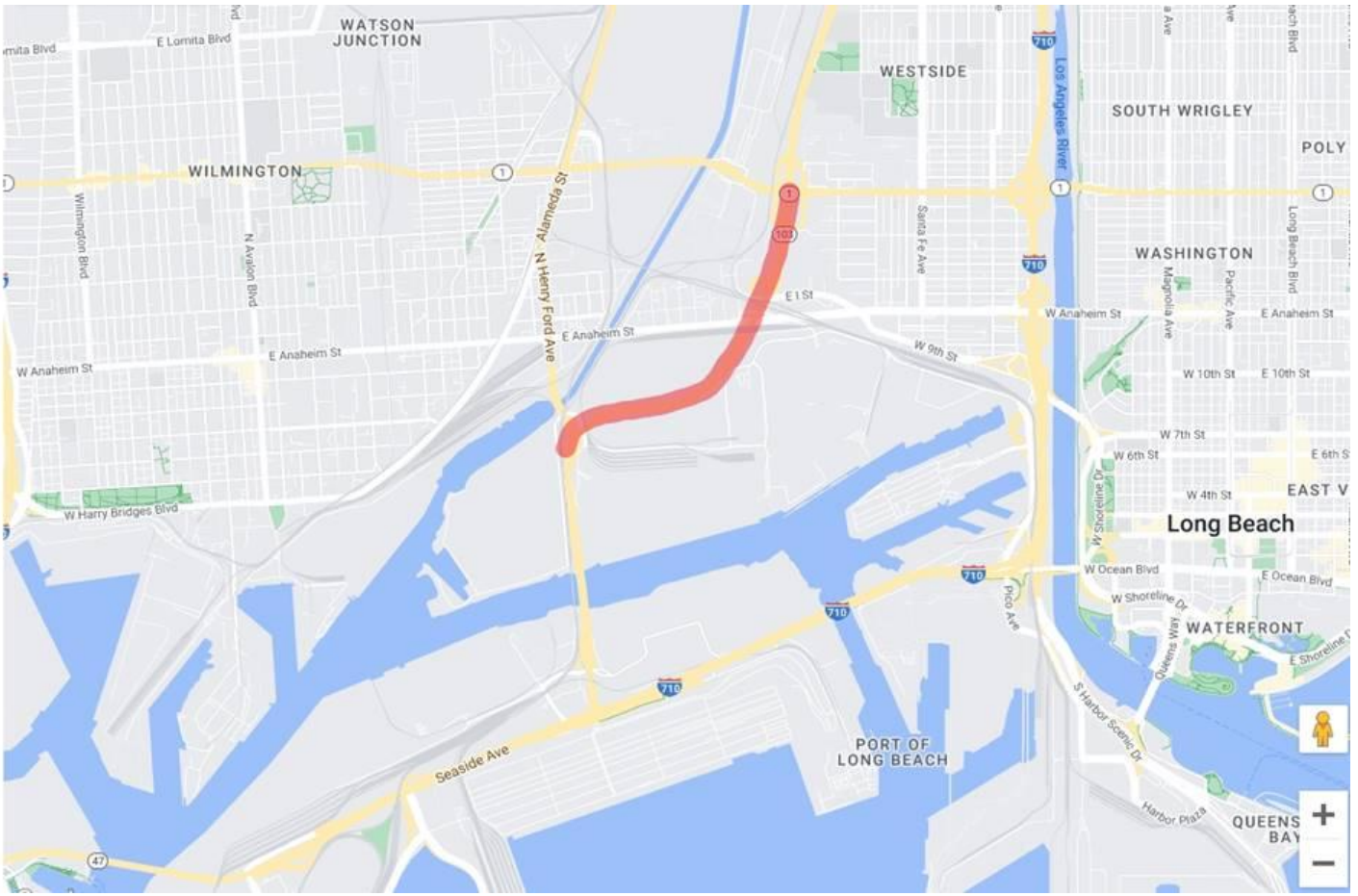
Construction on SR-103 is scheduled to be completed in spring 2026

Upon completion of all work the existing Union Pacific Overhead concrete bridge deck will be replaced with a new bridge and bridge railings to meet current bridge standards. The new deck will increase the lifespan of the bridge and bring the bridge to good service conditions. Lighting will also be added and will enhance the safety.

As a reminder please do not drive around road closed signs, road closed by a cone line, a flagman directing traffic, or any other traffic control devices.

Please use caution in the area and “Slow for the Cone Zone.”

Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
